

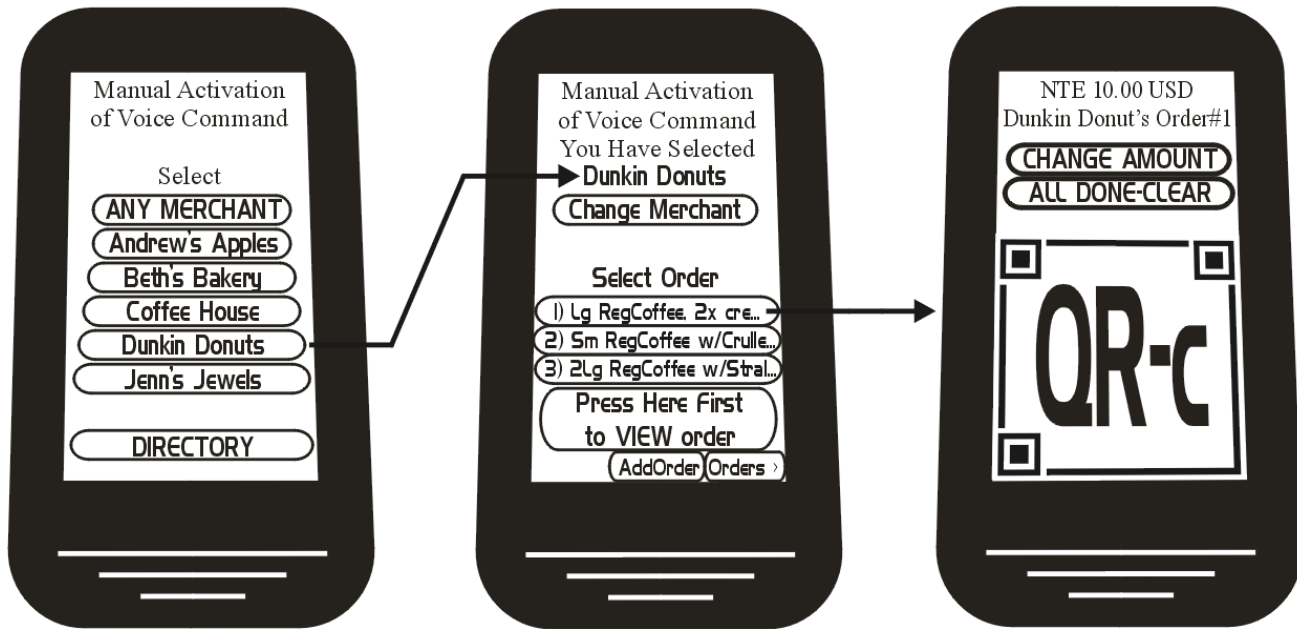
Order Prepared in Advance

I go to Dunkin' Donuts™ often. Sometimes I'm in a real hurry so I decide to prepare an order in advance. I look up Dunkin's merchant identification code on their web site. Scanning it creates an entry in my merchant table. I create an order for large coffee with double cream, no sugar, an apple fritter and a chocolate covered cream filled bismark. Next time I go, I can access the list of merchants with orders...

... select Dunkin' Donuts ...

... then select order #1 ...

... and my device displays this



I get in line, present it to the scanner, and get scanned. A green light shows a good scan, but because the actual amount *hadn't* been set the merchant's system does not yet communicate the consumer's charge authorization to the provider.

When I get to the cashier the confections are ready and the coffee prepared to perfection. The actual total was \$5.21. The charge is presented by the merchant to the provider, gets approved and I decline a paper receipt.
