


Voice Command & Coupons

In my local paper I read about Dunkin' DonutsTM having a standing special offer for members of the *American Association of Retired Persons* (AARP). You get a donut at no charge with each large coffee. The paper gave a web site address where there was a special QR-mId code with everything needed to create an order for voice or manual command.
